I look forward to seeing one of your students get into a trade through this (secretly hoping for a sheet metal worker apprentice). This is an opportunity to start a rewarding and successful career right out of high school. There is a Scholarship fund now in place that a student can access. Dollars For Scholars "Joel S Waterman Build America" is what I'm told its listed as. There is a series of questions that all give a score for what we are looking for in an applicant to join in the trades. This scholarship is for anyone with interest in any trade, not just the Sheet Metal Workers Union specifically.

Aaron Walter, General Contractor/ Superintendent, and a friend of mine and Joels' has worked hard on this. Joel Waterman, better known as Spartacus, was a resident of Altmar and I believe attended APW along with his 2 brothers John & Jim.

The apprenticeship program will not leave one with financial debt, as college would, and it accumulates college credits during the program. When I joined the Sheet Metal Workers Union (LU#83 Albany NY) on June 20th 1998, I paid \$100 to start my 5 year apprenticeship. I was given back the \$100 when I graduated 5 years later! If any of the students who are interested in being in a trade has any questions and wants to talk to someone, I'd be glad to talk to them in person or over the phone.
